GSSF Course of Fire Updates

GSSF updated their courses of fire in November, 2016. There are two changes that will have a minor impact on the matches at Target World:

*The Original Course of Fire, which Target World uses, has been updated. The noticeable change is the order in which the targets are engaged at different distances. For example, the 25 yard engagement

used to be the first engagement on the second target; it is now the last engagement on the second target. This could very well prove to be an advantage to those who have difficulty with the 25 yard engagement.

*New: Pocket Glock Course of Fire. Do you own a G42 or G43 Pocket Glock? If you do, try the Pocket Glock Course of Fire. Five, five-round en-

agements (25 rounds), at distances between three and fifteen yards. The maximum possible score is 250 points, which qualifies the winner for a plaque and a 250 Patch, which are now available.
